Applications may be faxed, emailed or mailed, as per the instructions below:

1. Complete the application and provide information as requested.
2. Send your completed application to The Rotary Club of Lexington at trafton@rotarylexky.org. The application may also be returned by your sponsor(s) or given to the Executive Director at a club meeting.
3. After your application is received you will receive an e-mail confirmation. You will then be interviewed by our Membership Committee and your application will be submitted to The Board of Directors for review & approval, the Club will be notified by publishing your name in our "Wheelhorse" newsletter. After a 7 day waiting period, should no objections arise, you will be considered approved for membership you will be notified immediately.

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
